### **New ZBasic Compiler Version Released**

Beaverton, OR - May 05, 2006 -- Elba Corporation announced today the availability of a new version of the ZBasic compiler for ZX microcontrollers. The v1.2.0 release incorporates support for user-defined types (structures). The benefit of using structures is that they allow the programmer to more accurately model the problem domain of their application resulting in code that is easier to create, understand and modify in the future.

The new version of the compiler also supports extended versions of the SPI and I2C commands that allow transfers of more than 255 bytes. Other changes include optimization enhancements, improvements to the X10 command and correction of some newly reported issues.

The compiler update is available from <http://www.zbasic.net/download/> at no charge as part of an installer containing the compiler, IDE and documentation.
